

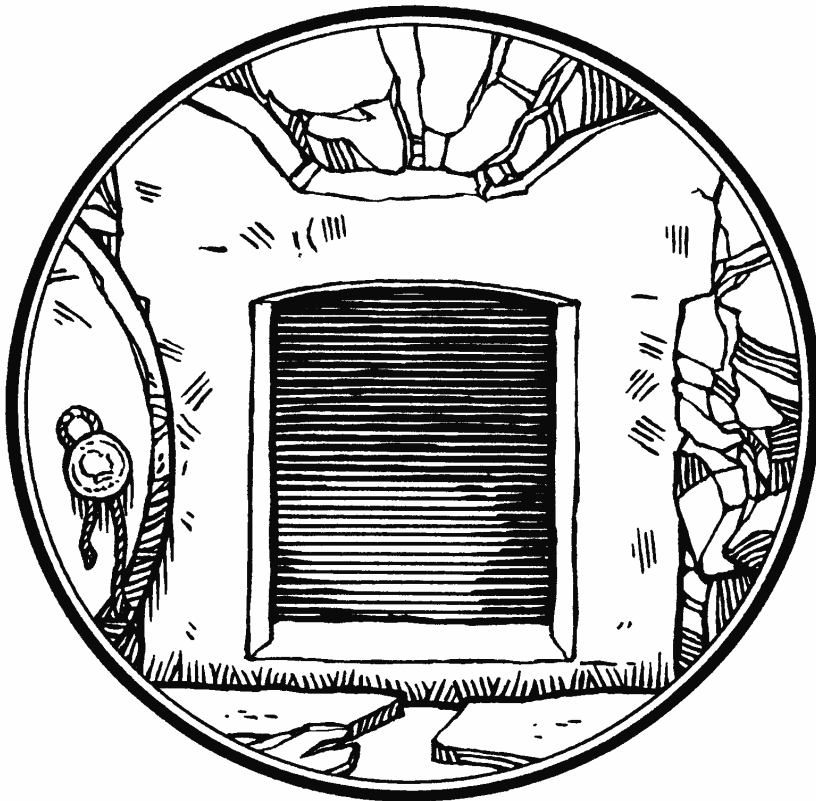

Nicene Creed
