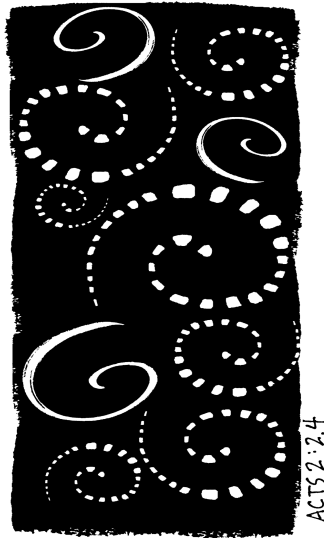

²⁴“But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.²⁵”For David says of Him, ‘I SAW THE LORD ALWAYS IN MY PRESENCE; FOR HE IS AT MY RIGHT HAND, SO THAT I WILL NOT BE SHAKEN. ²⁶‘THEREFORE MY HEART WAS GLAD AND MY TONGUE EXULTED; MOREOVER MY FLESH

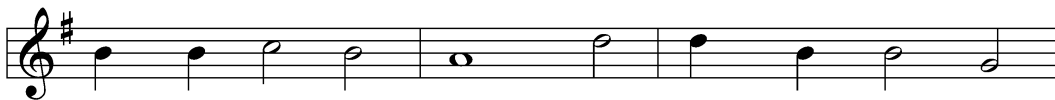



#2. The Plan & Foreknowledge

Acts 2:23 - “...this Man, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death.”

- Two things at work
 - “Predetermined plan” (*Eph 1:4, 1 Peter 1:19-20*)
 - “Foreknowledge”
 - All-knowing (omniscient) – (*1 John 3:20, Matt 10:29f, Heb 4:12f, Ps 147:5, Is 46:10*)
 - Know – (*Gen 4:1, Matt 1:25*)
 - Foreknowledge – foreknowledge of man vs foreknowledge of God
- Romans 11:1-2** - I say then, God has not rejected His people, has He? May it never be! For I too am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. 2 God has not rejected His people whom He foreknew...
