## **Communion Invitation**


Dear Guest: If you are not a member of the Lutheran Church- Missouri Synod, please speak to pastor before taking the Lord's Supper.



### **First Reading**

### Acts 9:32-43

<sup>32</sup>Now as Peter was traveling through all those regions, he came down also to the saints who lived at Lydda. <sup>33</sup>There he found a man named Aeneas, who had been bedridden eight years, for he was paralyzed. <sup>34</sup> Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you; get up and make your bed." Immediately he got up. <sup>35</sup>And all who lived at Lydda and Sharon saw him, and they turned to the Lord.

<sup>36</sup>Now in Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (which translated in Greek is called Dorcas); this woman was abounding with deeds of kindness and charity which she continually did. <sup>37</sup> And it happened at that time that she fell sick and died; and when they had washed her body, they laid it in an upper room. <sup>38</sup>Since Lydda was near Joppa, the disciples, having heard that Peter was there, sent two men to him, imploring him, "Do not delay in coming to us." <sup>39</sup>So Peter arose and went with them. When he arrived, they brought him into the upper room; and all the widows stood beside him, weeping and showing all the tunics and garments that Dorcas used to make while she was with them. <sup>40</sup>But Peter sent them all out and knelt down and prayed, and turning to the body, he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter, she sat up. <sup>41</sup>And he gave her his hand and raised her up; and calling the saints and widows, he presented her alive. <sup>42</sup> It became known all over Joppa, and many believed in the Lord. <sup>43</sup>And Peter stayed many days in Joppa with a tanner named Simon.

# **Epistle**

# 1 Thessalonians 5:1–11

<sup>1</sup>Now as to the times and the epochs, brethren, you have no need of anything to be written to you. <sup>2</sup>For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night. <sup>3</sup>While they are saying, "Peace and safety!" then destruction will come upon them suddenly like labor pains upon a woman with child, and they will not escape. <sup>4</sup>But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that the day would overtake you like a thief; <sup>5</sup> for you are all sons of light and sons of day. We are not of night nor of darkness; <sup>6</sup> so then let us not sleep as others do, but let us be alert and sober. <sup>7</sup>For those who sleep do their sleeping at night, and those who get drunk get drunk at night. <sup>8</sup>But since we are of the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet, the hope of salvation. <sup>9</sup>For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>10</sup>who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep, we will live together with Him. <sup>11</sup>Therefore encourage one another and build up one another, just as you also are doing.

Matthew 25:1–13

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the twenty-fifth chapter.



<sup>1</sup> "Then the kingdom of heaven will be comparable to ten virgins, who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. <sup>2</sup>Five of them were foolish, and five were prudent. <sup>3</sup>For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them, <sup>4</sup>but the prudent took oil in flasks along with their lamps. <sup>5</sup>Now while the bridegroom was delaying, they all got drowsy and began to sleep. <sup>6</sup>But at midnight there was a shout, 'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' <sup>7</sup>Then all those virgins rose and trimmed their lamps. <sup>8</sup>The foolish said to the prudent, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' <sup>9</sup>But the prudent answered, 'No, there will not be enough for us and you too; go instead to the dealers and buy some for yourselves.' <sup>10</sup>And while they were going away to make the purchase, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast; and the door was shut. <sup>11</sup> Later the other virgins also came, saying, 'Lord, lord, open up for us.' <sup>12</sup>But he answered, 'Truly I say to you, I do not know you.' <sup>13</sup> Be on the alert then, for you do not know the day nor the hour."

# **Apostles' Creed**


C I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.








# The Words of Our Lord


P Our Lord Jesus Christ, on the night when He was betrayed, took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to the disciples and said:
