Numbers 10:35-36 -

Then it came about when the ark set out that Moses said,
 "Rise up, O Lord!
 And let Your enemies be scattered,
 And let those who hate You flee before You."

When it came to rest, he said, "Return, O LORD, To the myriad thousands of Israel."

II Samuel 6:2 -

² And David arose and went with all the people who were with him to Baale-judah, to bring up from there the ark of God which is called by the Name, the very name of the LORD of hosts who is enthroned *above* the cherubim.
