You may, however, come up to the altar today to receive a blessing. Simply <u>cross your arms over your chest</u> while you are kneeling at the communion rail. You may also remain in your pew during Communion if you so desire.



The sign of the cross may be made by all in remembrance of their Baptism.

- P Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the T Son and of the Holy Spirit.

And wine to him whose life is bitter.



Holy Gospel (NASB95)

John 16:16-22


Apostles' Creed




The Words of Our Lord

A Let us pray.


